

HUBBARD COUNCIL MINUTES

Appeal Hearing

August 18, 2022 - 6:00 P.M.

The Hubbard City Council met in special session in Council Chambers with Mayor Marshall Simmerman presiding and the following Council members present: Randy Smuck, Tracy Below, Chad Ball & Scott Cross, and Wes Kix. Also present were Amy Faris, Austin Faris, Chief Deputy Holmes, City Attorney Seth Schroeder, and Hector Lopez (6:04pm).

APPROVAL OF AGENDA-Motion by Ball, seconded by Below to approve the agenda. AMVA. (All members voted aye).

APPEAL HEARING – *Dog Removal Order Issued 8/12/2022 to Laurie Gardner and Hector Lopez.*

Mayor gave a recap of the incident that occurred and the process that has followed including quarantine of the dogs, serving of the order to remove and events leading to the appeal hearing. Mayor invited Hector Lopez, owner of the dogs, to present his statement. Lopez stated that he would like to put up a better fence all around the property and claimed that this has never happened before. Council member Cross addressed Lopez stating that large dog has been at the golf course and that they have had to call them to have the dog picked up. Mayor stated that after this attack incident, more people have come forward with their own experiences with the dogs surrounding them while walking. Motion by Cross, seconded by Ball to affirm the order of removal of all dogs from the city limits. Roll: Ayes – Smuck, Kix, Ball, Below, Cross.

Order confirming removal of dogs signed by all council members and served by Chief Deputy Holmes immediately.
