

ORDINANCE NO. 395

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HUBBARD, IOWA, BY AMENDING AND ADDING NEW SECTIONS AT LARGE PROHIBITED AND INVISIBLE DOG FENCE.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Hubbard, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 55.06 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hubbard, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

55.06 AT LARGE PROHIBITED.

1. It is unlawful for any owner to allow an animal to run at large within the corporate limits of the City.
2. The owner or custodian of any animal that runs at large at any time within the City shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor. An animal shall be deemed running at large unless it is located within the fenced premises of its owner, contained within a duly operational invisible electric fence, attached to a leash held by a competent person or secured by leash upon and within the owner's property to prevent escape, restrained within a motor vehicle; or in a building, animal hospital or kennel.

SECTION 2 NEW SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Hubbard, Iowa, is amended by adding a new Section 55.21, which is hereby adopted to read as follows:

55.21 INVISIBLE FENCE. Any resident confining a dog with an electronic fence or electronic collar must clearly post a sign on the property indicating the use of such device. Dogs are prohibited from being closer than 3 feet to any sidewalk or property line. Each day a fence is not in compliance is considered a separate offense.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
