Motion by Rieks, seconded by Reischauer to approve pay request #2 to SAM \$19,219.63 for GIS Mapping services. AMVA.

<u>COMMITTEE REPORTS</u>- No Report for Ambulance, Park, Pool, or Mayor. Reischauer reported that due to staff shortage, curbside recycling routes that fall on a holiday will not be rescheduled. Cross reported fire department members are finishing training hours for the year and applying for wildland gear grants. Ball reported Mayor and Clerk attended the last library board meeting to discuss financials. Clerk will be attending a budget workshop November 19th in Cedar Falls, city hall will be closed. Iowa Economic Development Community Attraction and Tourism final disbursement request and report has been submitted. Clerk will be meeting with property insurance agent and workers compensation agent to review policies.
